Description

Arne Jacobsen Pot Chair, model 3318, comprising a low-profile frame with a vessel-shaped seat that floats over four chromed steel legs. Deceptively spacious and comfortable chair that was originally designed by Jacobsen in 1959 for Copenhagen's SAS Royal Hotel along with the Egg and Swan chairs but considerably less well-recognized, likely due to its comparatively unassuming form. This example retains the original Fritz Hansen cognac leather upholstery which is distressed and displays all sorts of age-related wear. Signed to the underside. 1960s.
